Objectives

- Improve website user experience for all audiences.
- Direct each audience to the content that's most relevant to them as effectively as possible.

Audiences And Their Primary Goals

- End customers (consumers/ranchers)
 - gather information about kits and other large items
 - purchase smaller items online
 - find dealers
- Prospective dealers explore why and how to become a dealer.
- Prospective employees find job opportunities.
- Existing dealers find information tailored to them.
 - Future: provide a password-protected section with helpful resources.



OVERVIEW

Considerations

- Large corral systems (e.g., the Conquistador and other kits referenced in the PDFs provided) may not be purchased on the site. Rather, the site should provide information about the kits and encourage customers to call MJE for purchasing assistance and referral to a dealer.
- The ecommerce features of the site are applicable primarily to small items.
- Dealer listings are relevant to both end customers and prospective dealers.
- Dealers don't carry a lot of MJE inventory so adding a feature to product pages showing where items are in stock may not be particularly desirable.

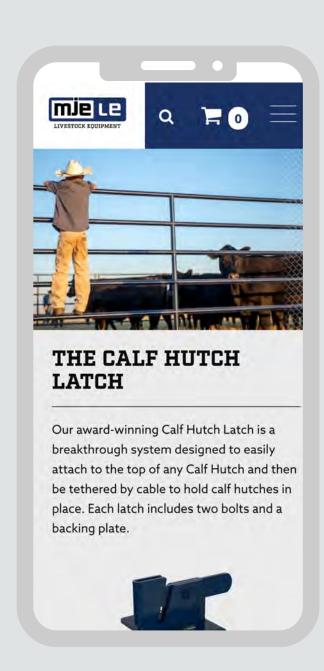
- How to promote the Conquistador to both dealers and end customers.
- How to present Packages or Kits to both dealers and end customers.
- How to incorporate resources and/or marketing materials for dealers.
- How to display the Dealer Network: To either become a dealer or find a dealer in your area.

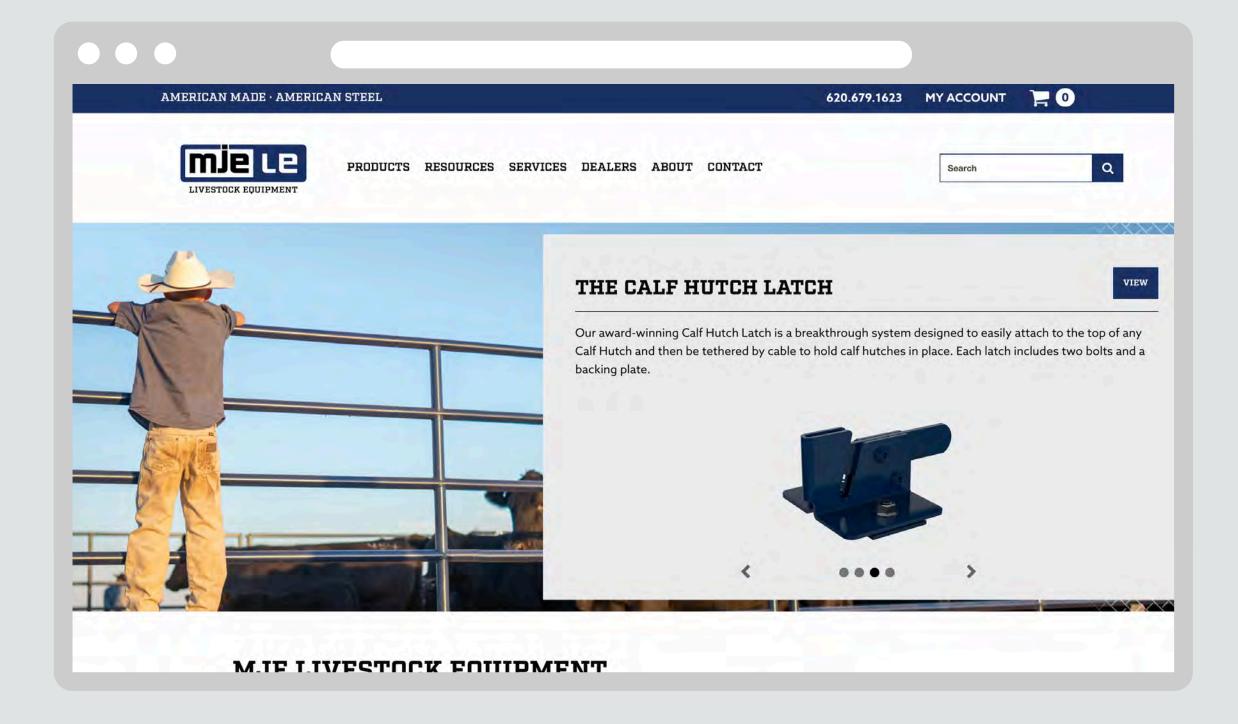


MOBILE VS DESKTOP

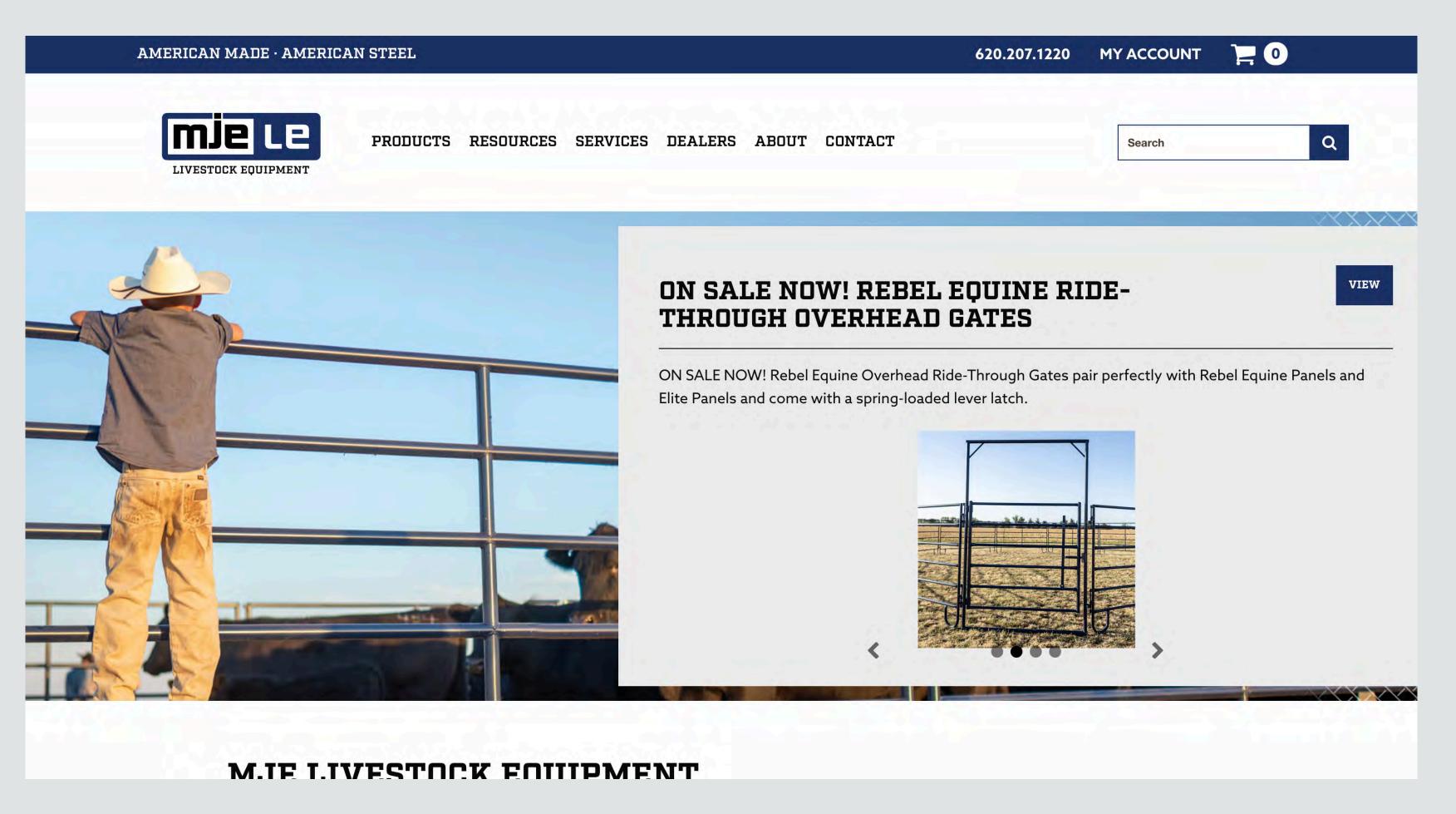
SITE UI DESIGN

According to Google Analytics, site search is rarely used. Could move it to the footer to save main nav screen real estate.

The overall site UI design is good: it's simple, intuitive and easy for the user to grasp.

Users often skip over carousels. If the content in the carousels is important, recommend making it visible on the page as static content.

"You can't count on people seeing the information in carousels on websites...people often...miss all of the content within them, or at least the content that's in any frame other than the first." (NNG)

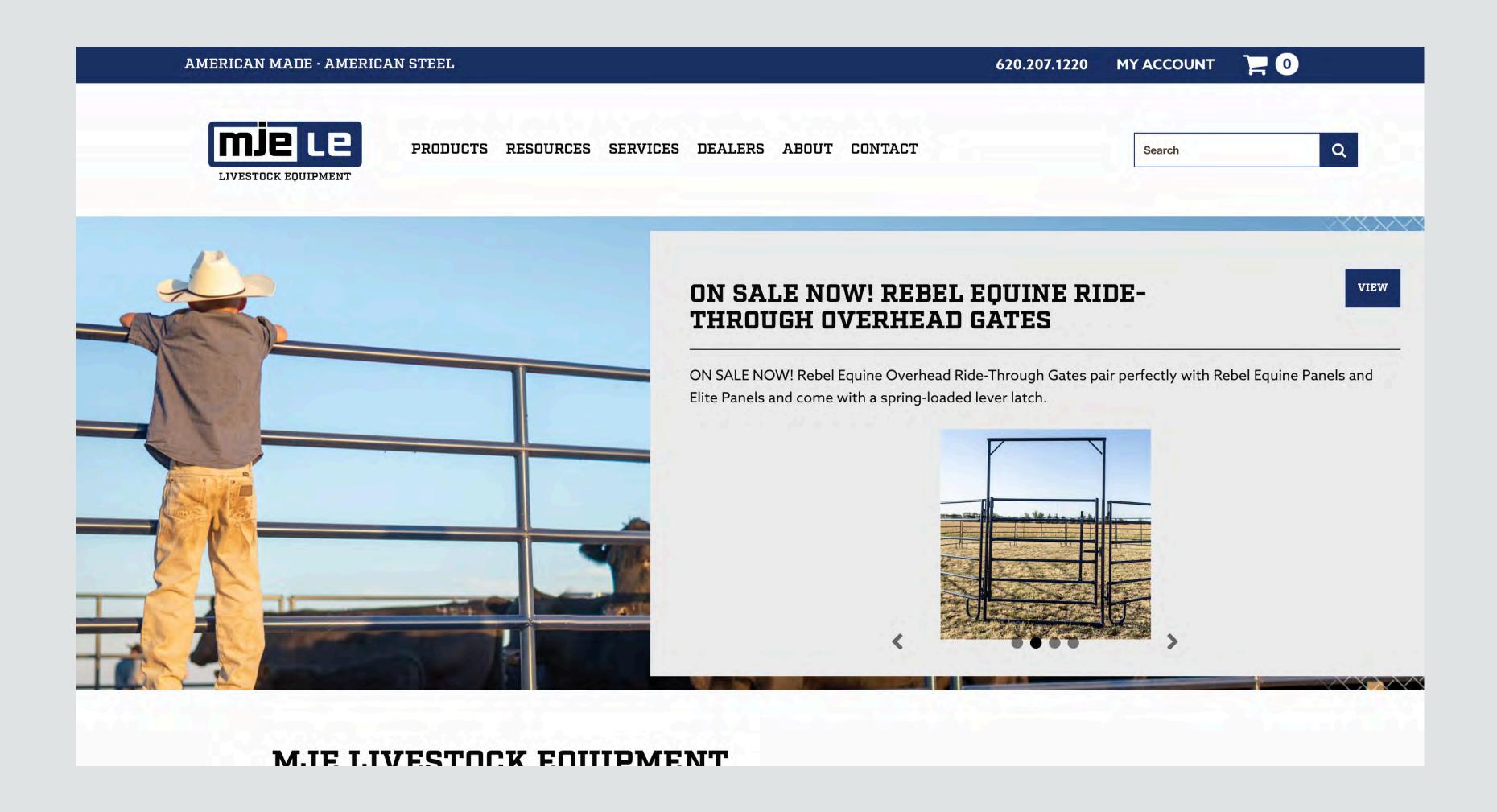




SITE NAVIGATION

The main navigation is simple, visible and does not overwhelm the user with too many links.

Two of the words in the main nav (Resources and Services) are somewhat ambiguous.





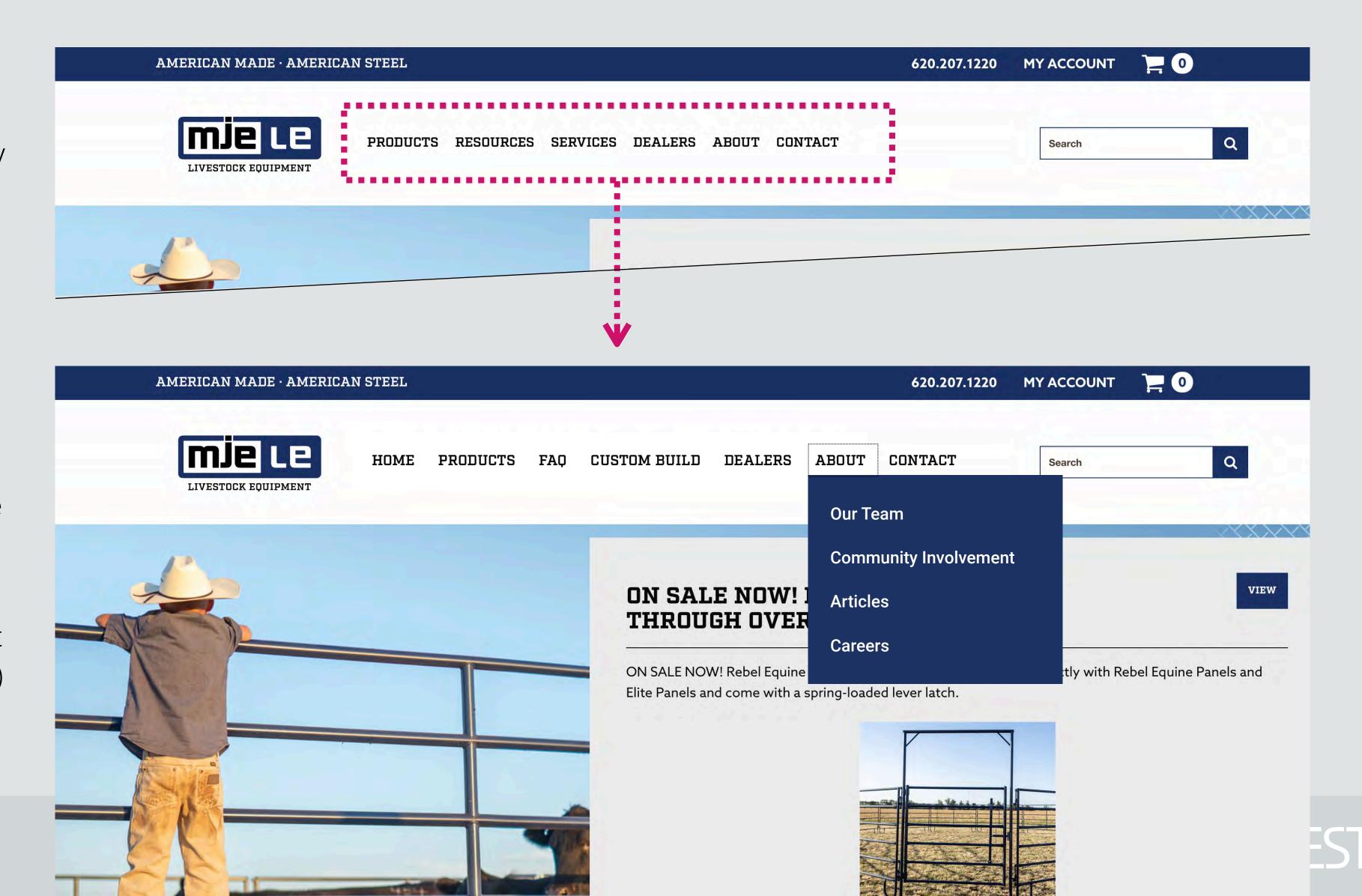
SITE NAVIGATION

Recommendations for changes to RESOURCES and SERVICES:

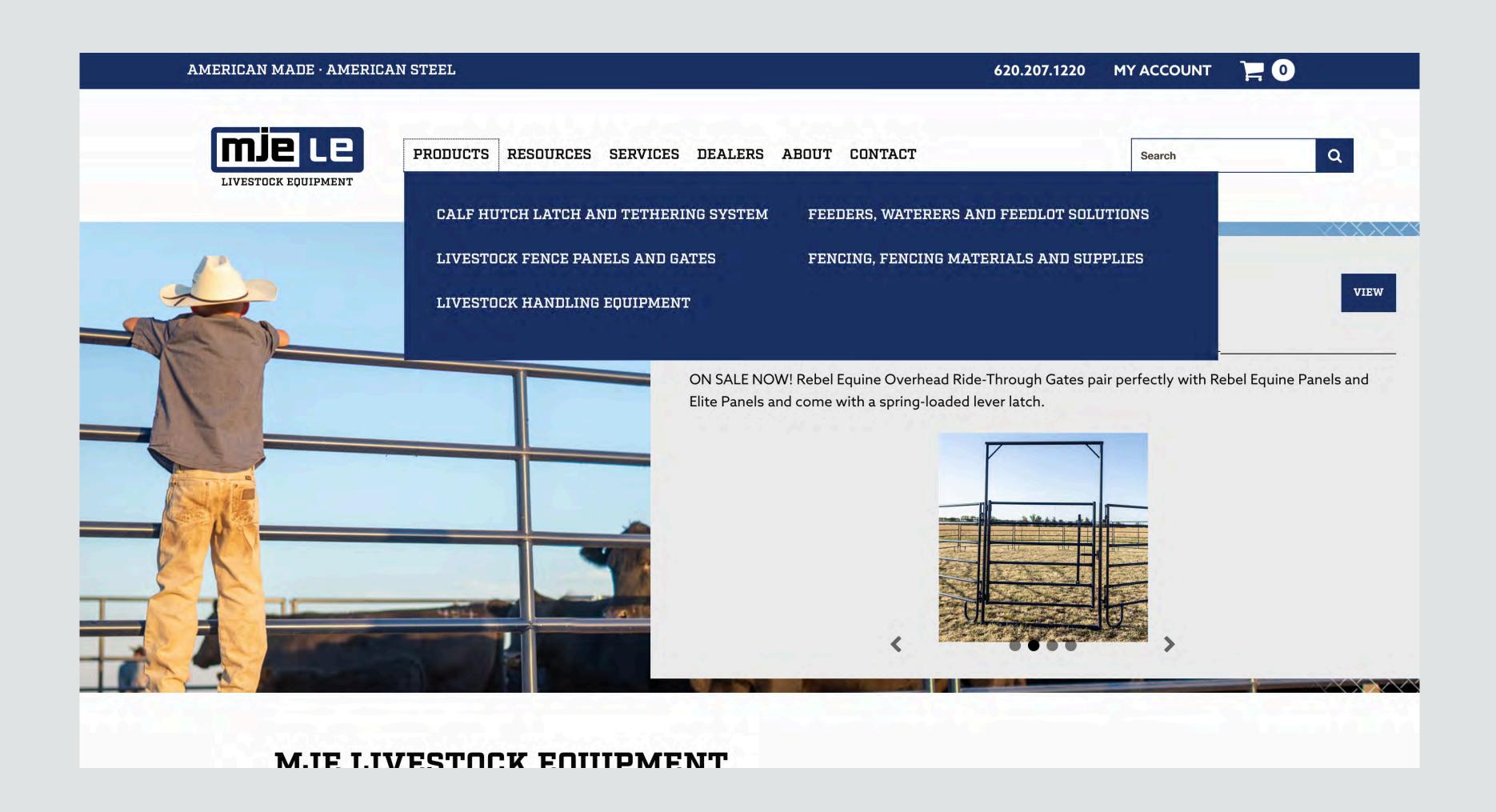
- Isolate FAQ in main nav (typically an often-used page).
- Put BLOG in ABOUT section and rename it "Articles."
- Change SERVICES to a more clear label (Custom Build, Custom Solutions, or Custom Manufacturing).

Additional recommendation for the main nav:

 Add HOME on desktop and mobile (not everyone knows that the logo a link to the home page)



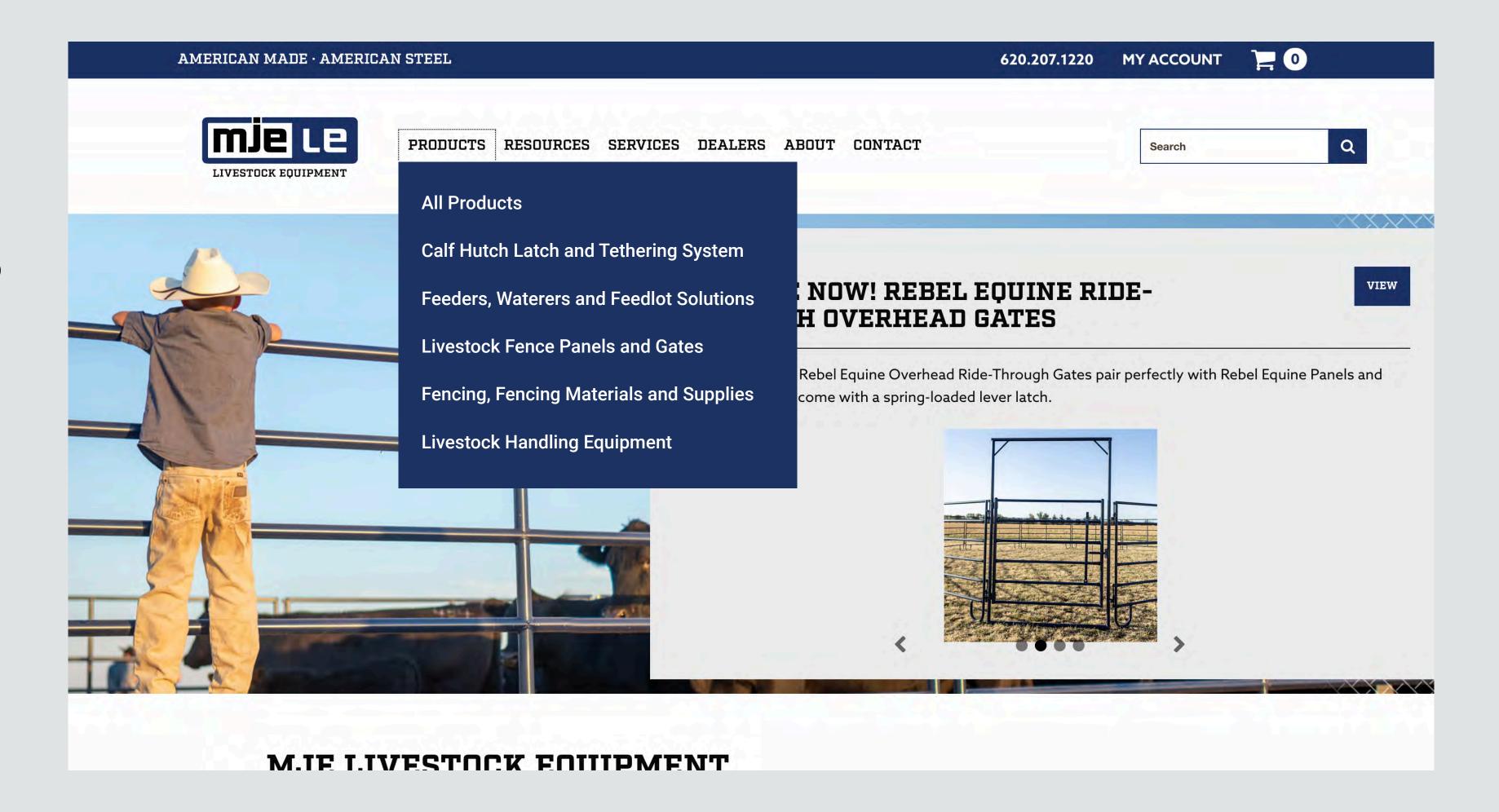
On the expanded main menu, the use of all caps and two columns reduces readability.





To improve readability:

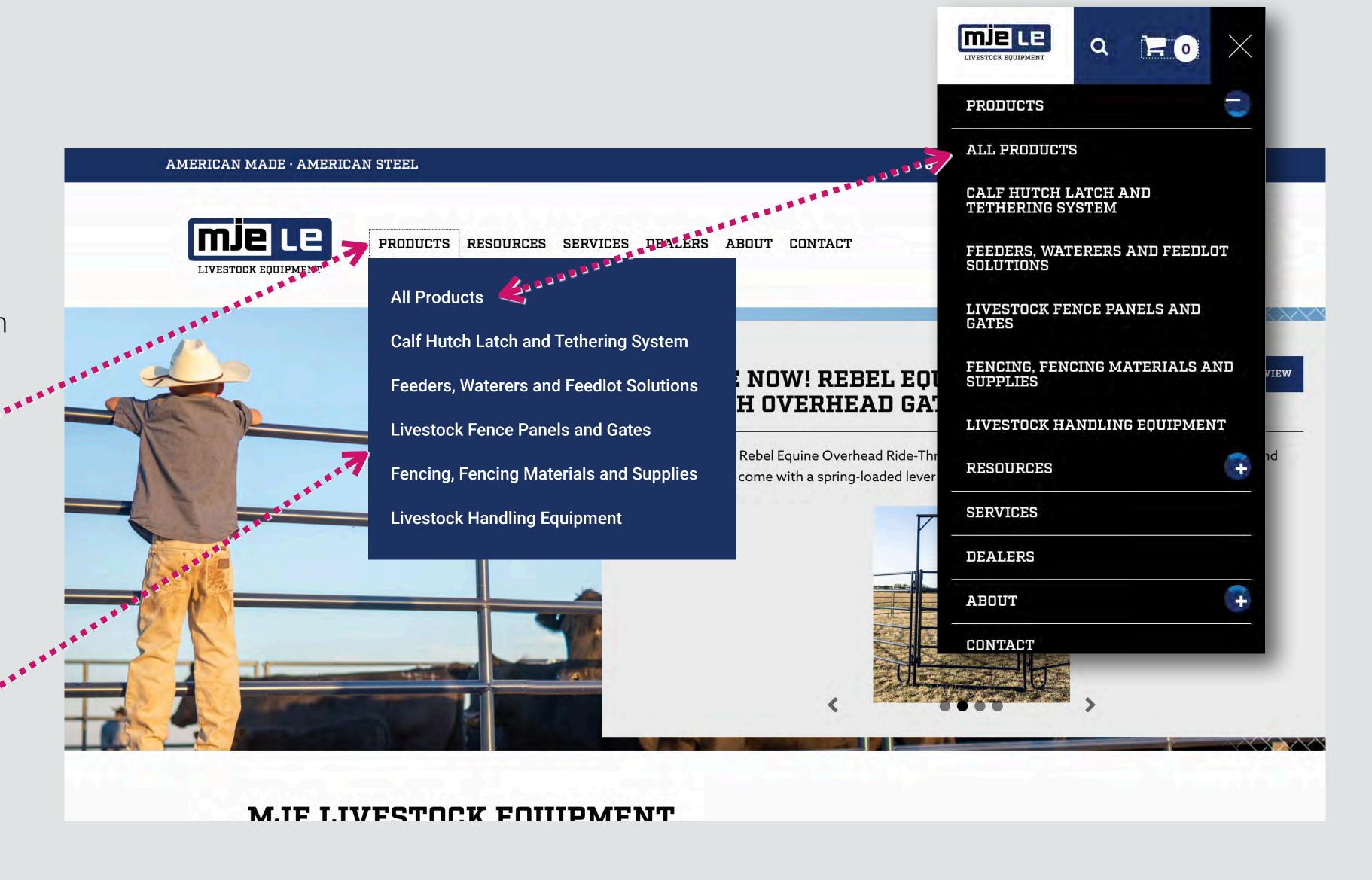
- Recommend using upper and lower case text in a single column.
- Consider changing the font to a less ornate sans-serif.





When users encounter a dropdown menu, they rarely click on the top-level (in this case, PRODUCTS) and instead go straight to one of the selections on the menu.

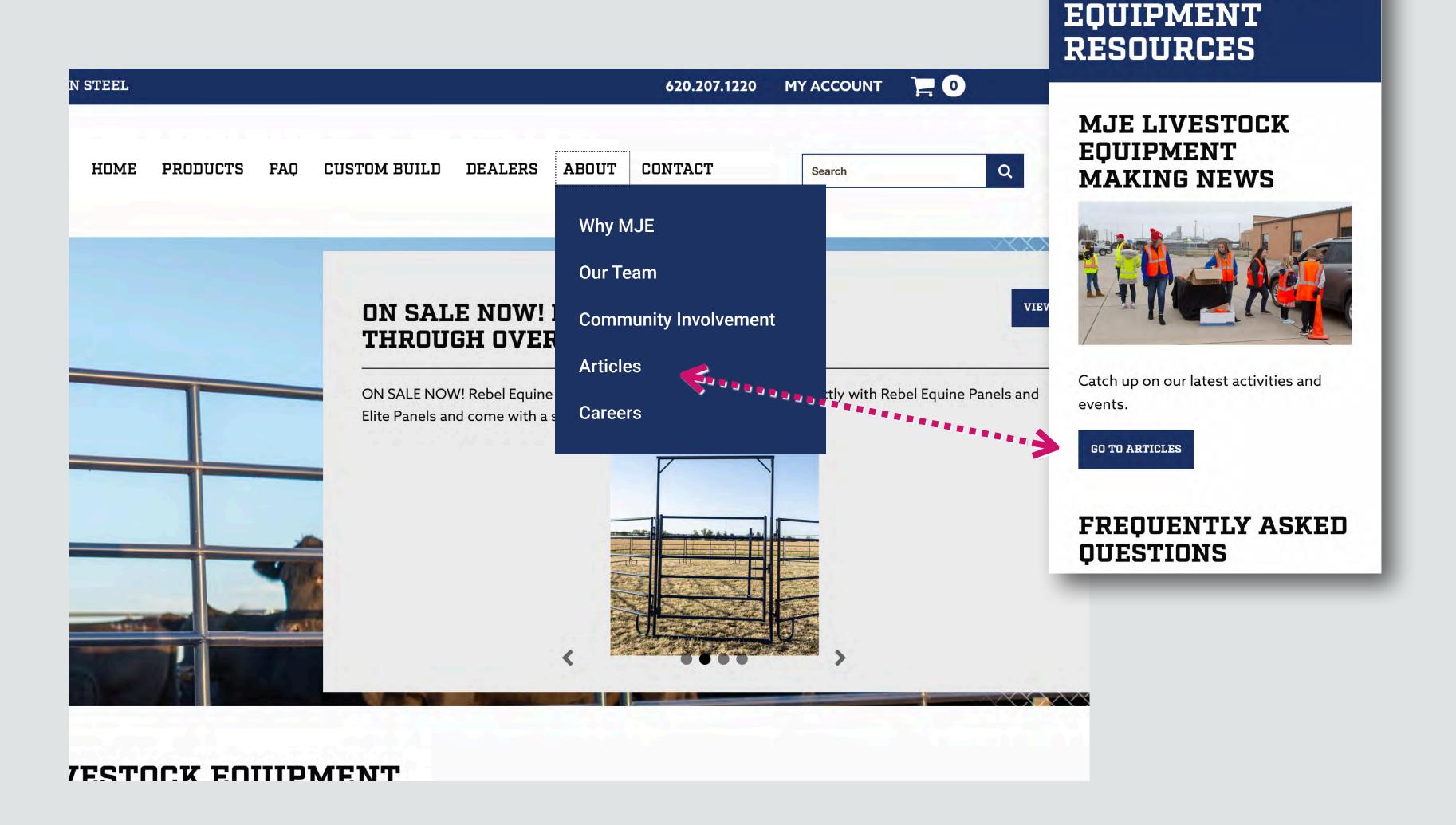
- Recommend making
 PRODUCTS in the main nav not clickable and adding "All Products" to the drop-down menu (like the mobile menu, which is set up correctly).
- Recommend reviewing categories — see page 27.





Recommend putting the BLOG in ABOUT section and rename it "Articles."

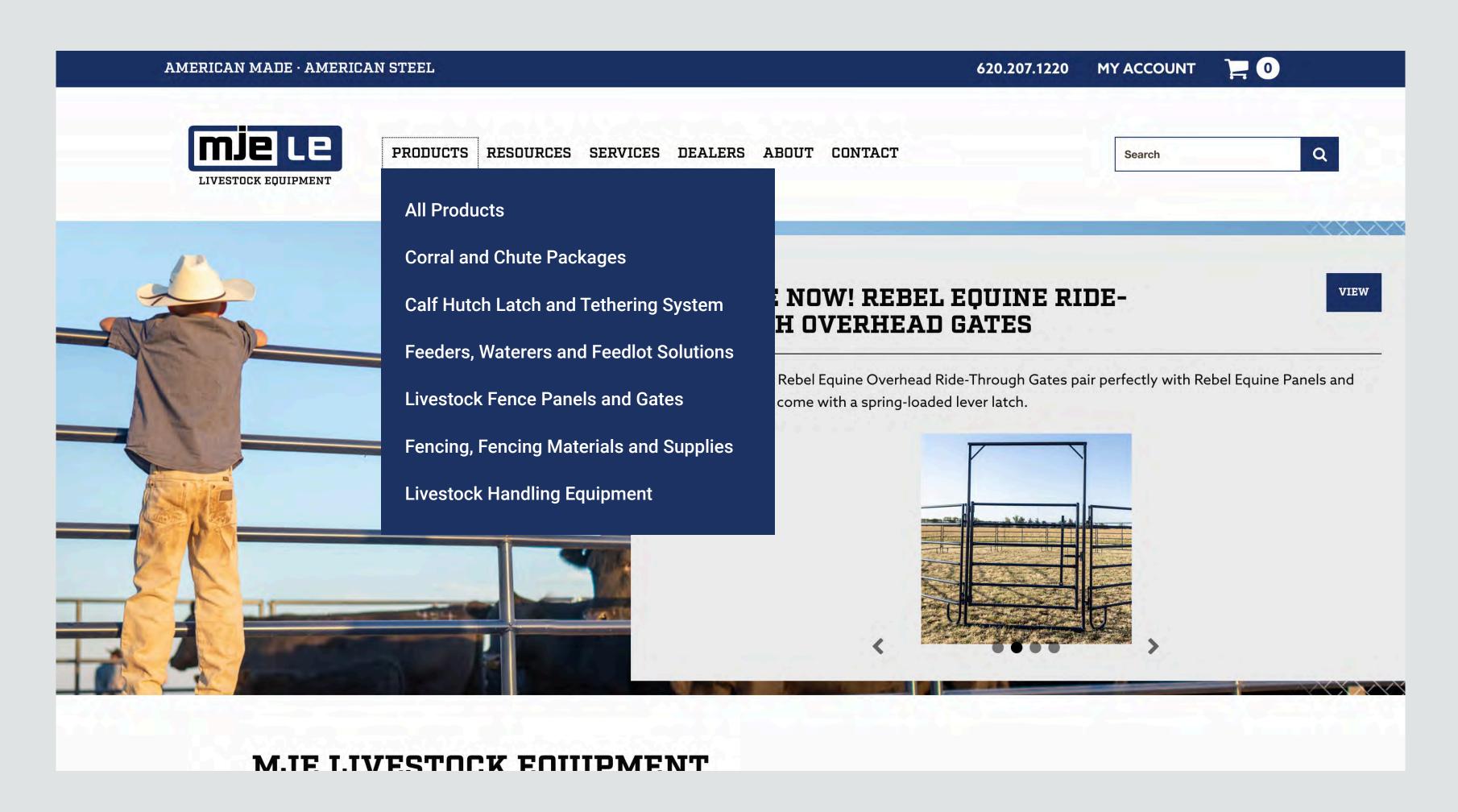
PACKAGES

Recommend adding the Packages at the top of the Products menu/ section.

Use a category name that's clear and descriptive, e.g.:

- Corral and Chute Packages
- Corral, Chute & Carrier Packages
- Corral Package Kits

Each Package should have a standard product page.

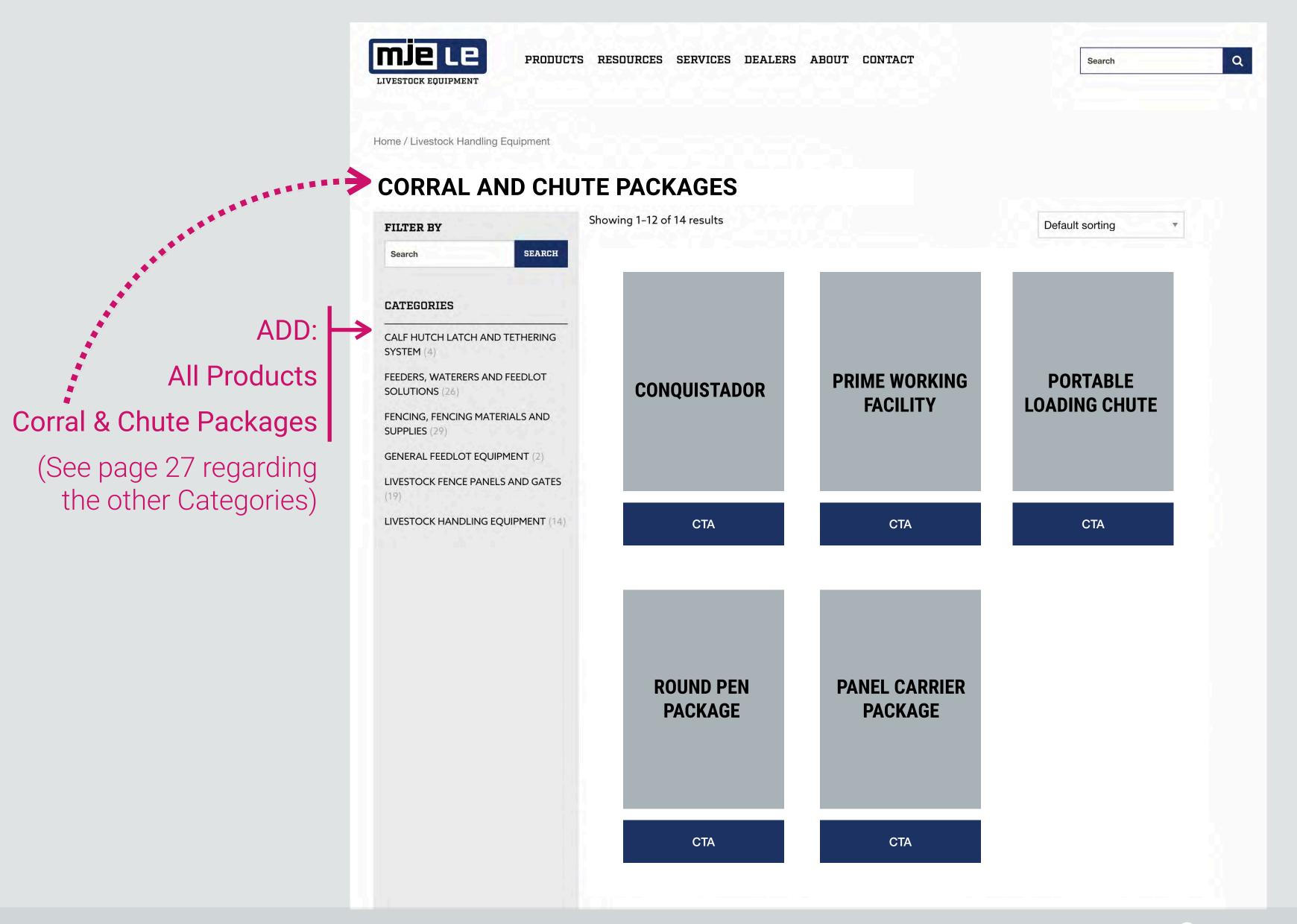




PACKAGES

The Packages category filter should display all Packages on one filtered Product page as shown here.

It's also ok to have separate content page(s) for the Conquistador or all of the Packages (e.g., as marketing landing pages in the Articles section). Any such pages should link to the product pages (example). Promotional landing pages should not duplicate all the info on the product page but rather lead the user to the product page (discuss).

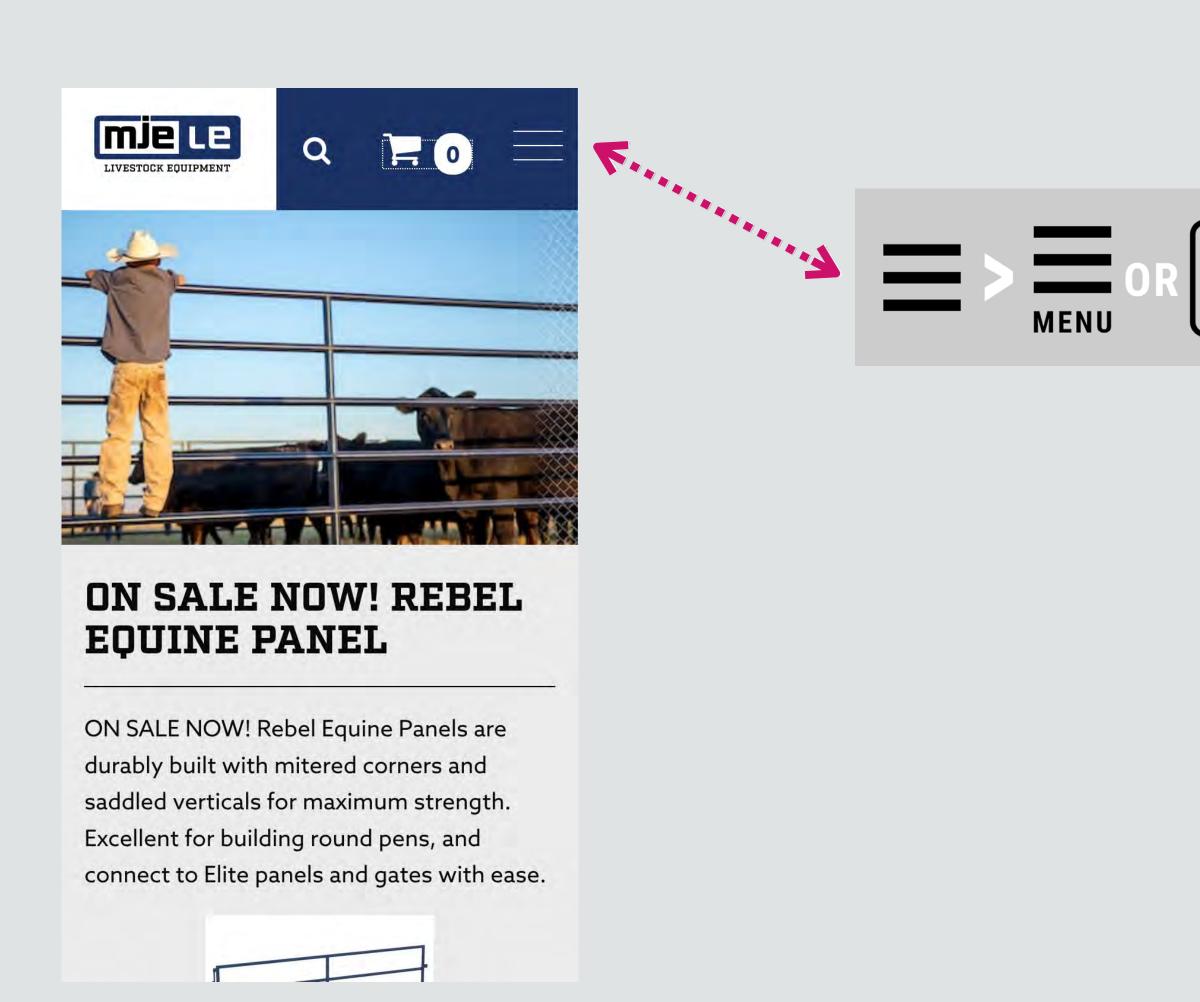




MOBILE MENU

The basic functionality of the mobile menu is good.

- Consider adding MENU under the hamburger icon or putting a border around it to clearly identify it as a button (either of which is <u>shown</u> to improve usability — not everyone understands hamburger icons).
- Consider making the hamburger icon lines bolder to improve contrast for visibility and accessibility.

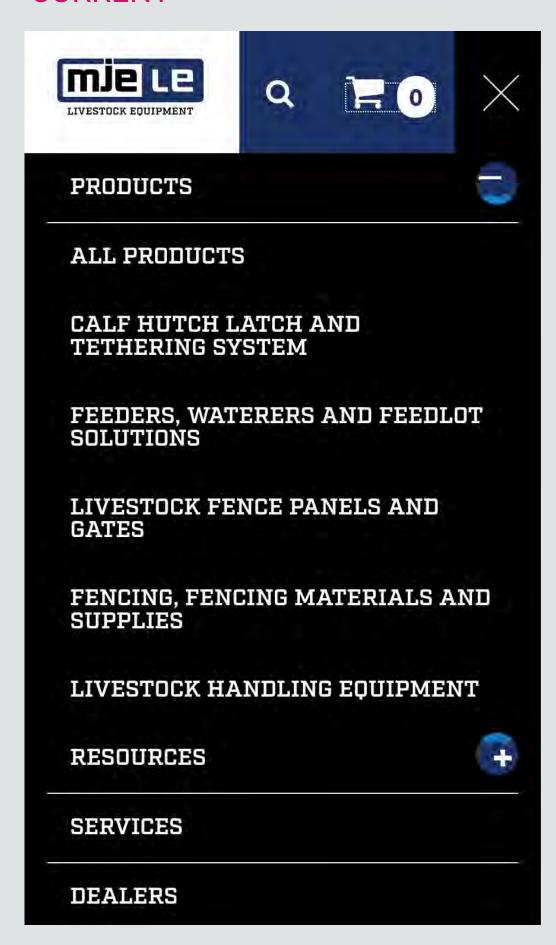




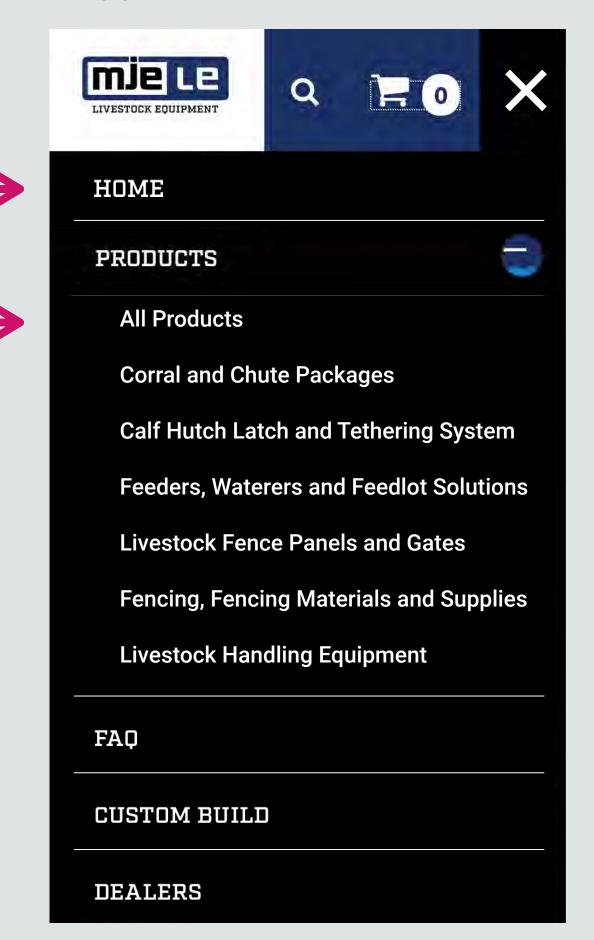
MOBILE MENU

- (A) Add a HOME link (not everyone knows the logo is the home button).
- (B) Make the sub-page titles upper and lower case for improved readability as noted for the desktop nav. Indent the sub-pages slightly and removing the white line under the section title to make it clear these are pages under a header.

FOOTER

Users often look to the footer if they can't find what they want in the main navigation. In addition, there are a few particular links that users expect to find in the footer and sometimes look there first (even before even looking in the main nav). Those include:

- Contact
- About Us
- Careers/Jobs
- FAQ
- Account Login

For the most part the MJE-LE footer is good. A few recommended improvements are noted.

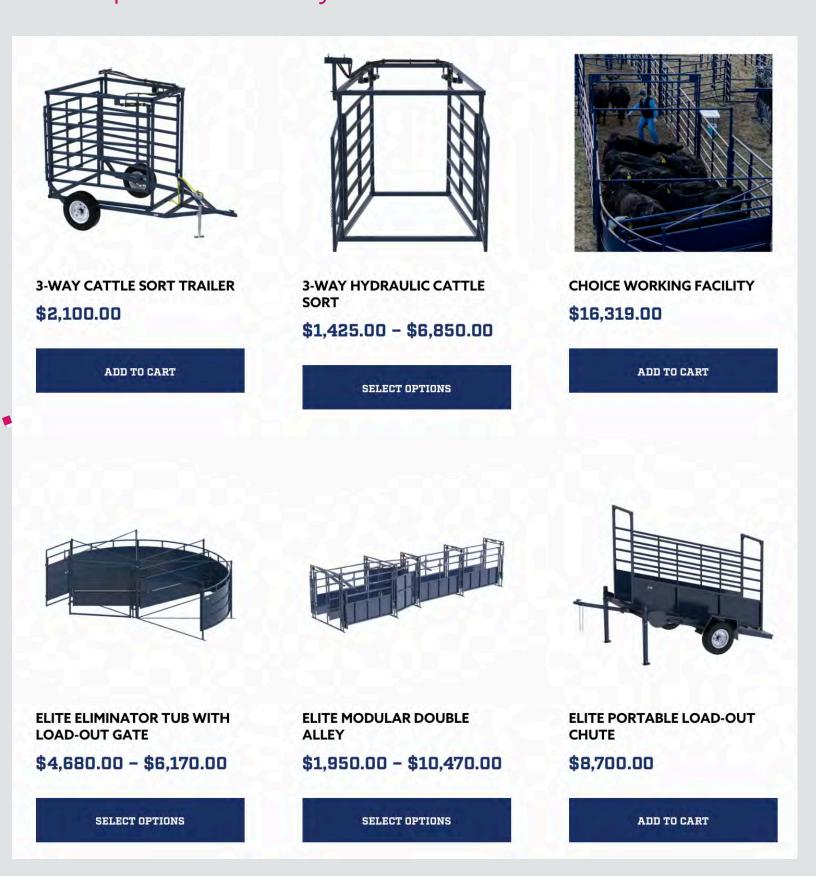


"ALL PRODUCTS" LANDING PAGE

As noted, https://mjelivestockequipment.com/products/ is the highest-traffic page on the site by a significant margin. Recommend changing the default order of the products so that you're displaying the most important products first.



What products do you want visitors to see first?

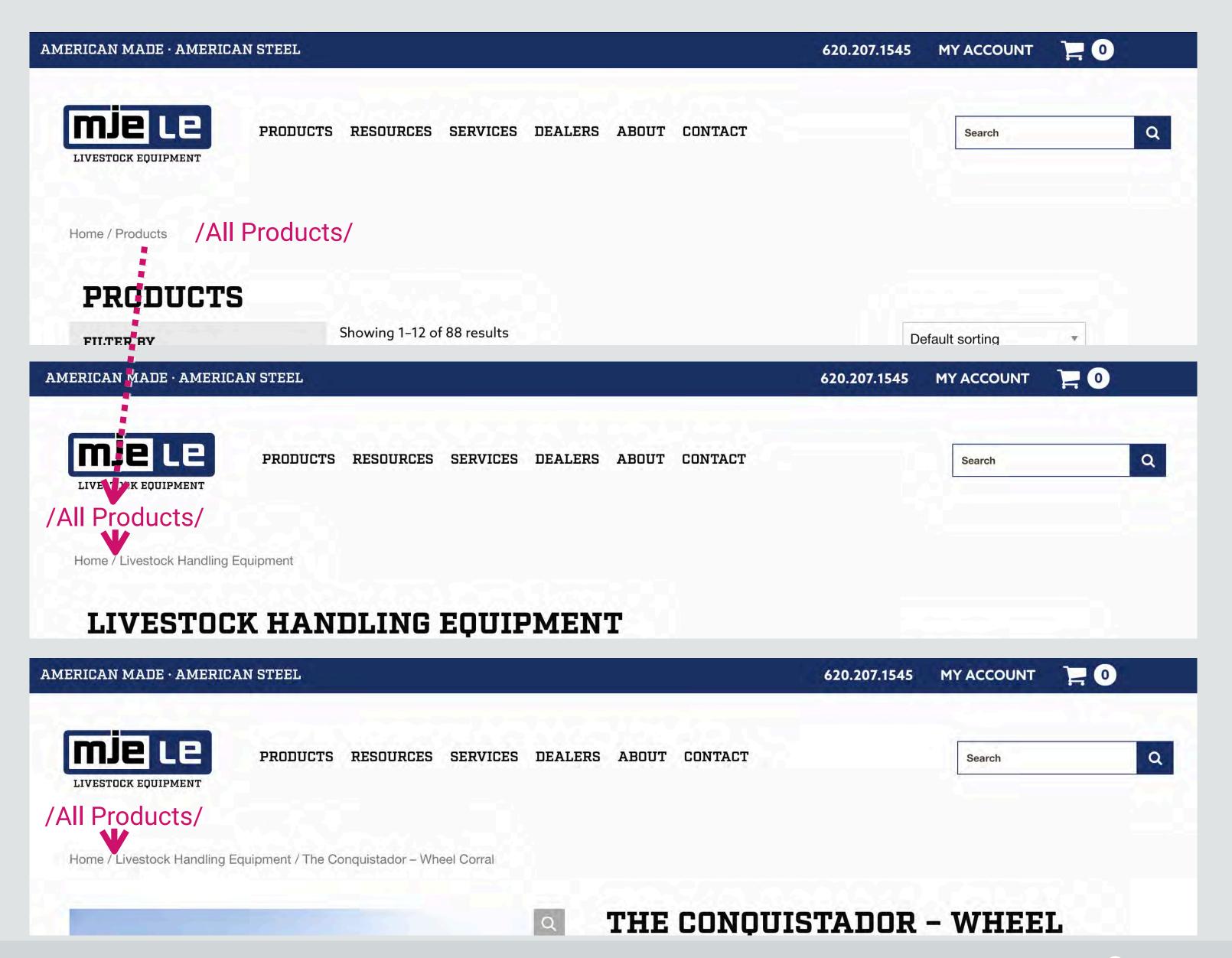




BREADCRUMBS

The Breadcrumbs are broken in the product section, making them confusing and reducing their ability to help with wayfinding (because while "Products" appears initially, once you get to a Category or a specific Product, it disappears so you can't use the breadcrumbs to get back to All Products). To fix the problem, add "All Products" after the Home link consistently.

Breadcrumbs appear only in the Product section. Consider adding Breadcrumbs site-wide to help with wayfinding and improved accessibility.



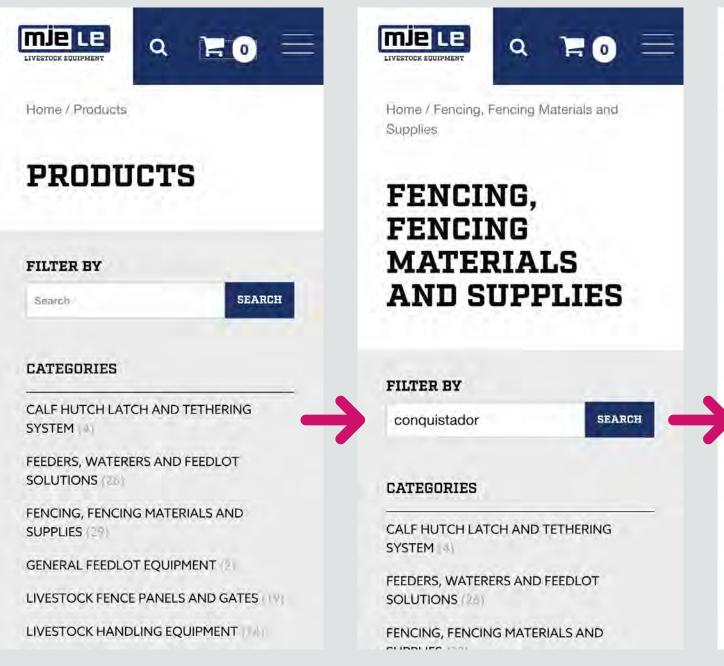


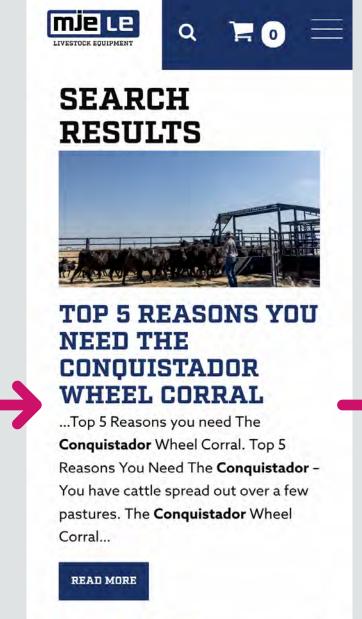
PRODUCT FILTER SEARCH

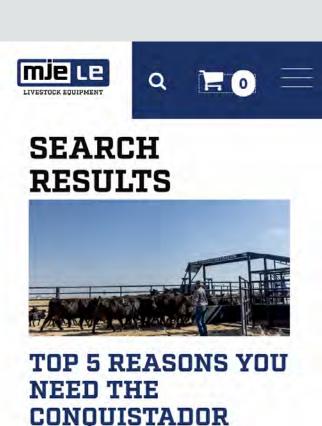
Strongly recommend removing the Search field under FILTER BY on the product pages (both desktop and mobile).

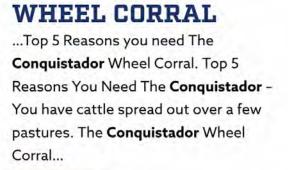
This is confusing because it implies you are searching in the product pages but actually it is a site-wide search.

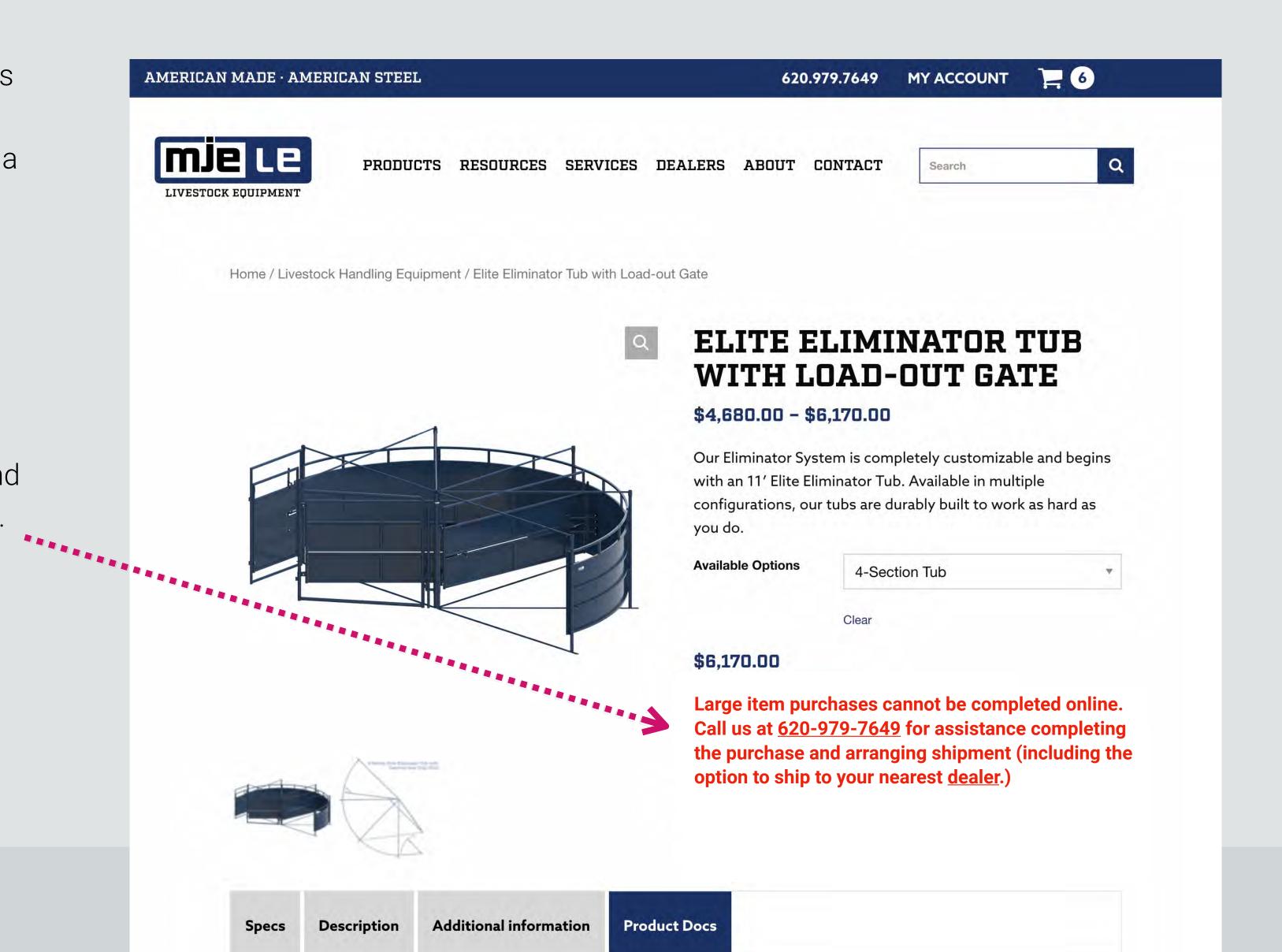


LARGE ITEMS-OPTION A (RECOMMENDED)

The process of allowing users to put large items in their shopping cart but not allowing them to easily complete the checkout process online is a less than ideal user experience.

The simplest solution to this is to remove the "Add To Cart" button from items that can't ship via USPS/UPS. (Also remove the social sharing icons and the tags on mobile.)

Replace the Add To Cart Button with a note explaining what to do (suggested copy here) and make the phone number click-to-dial on mobile.

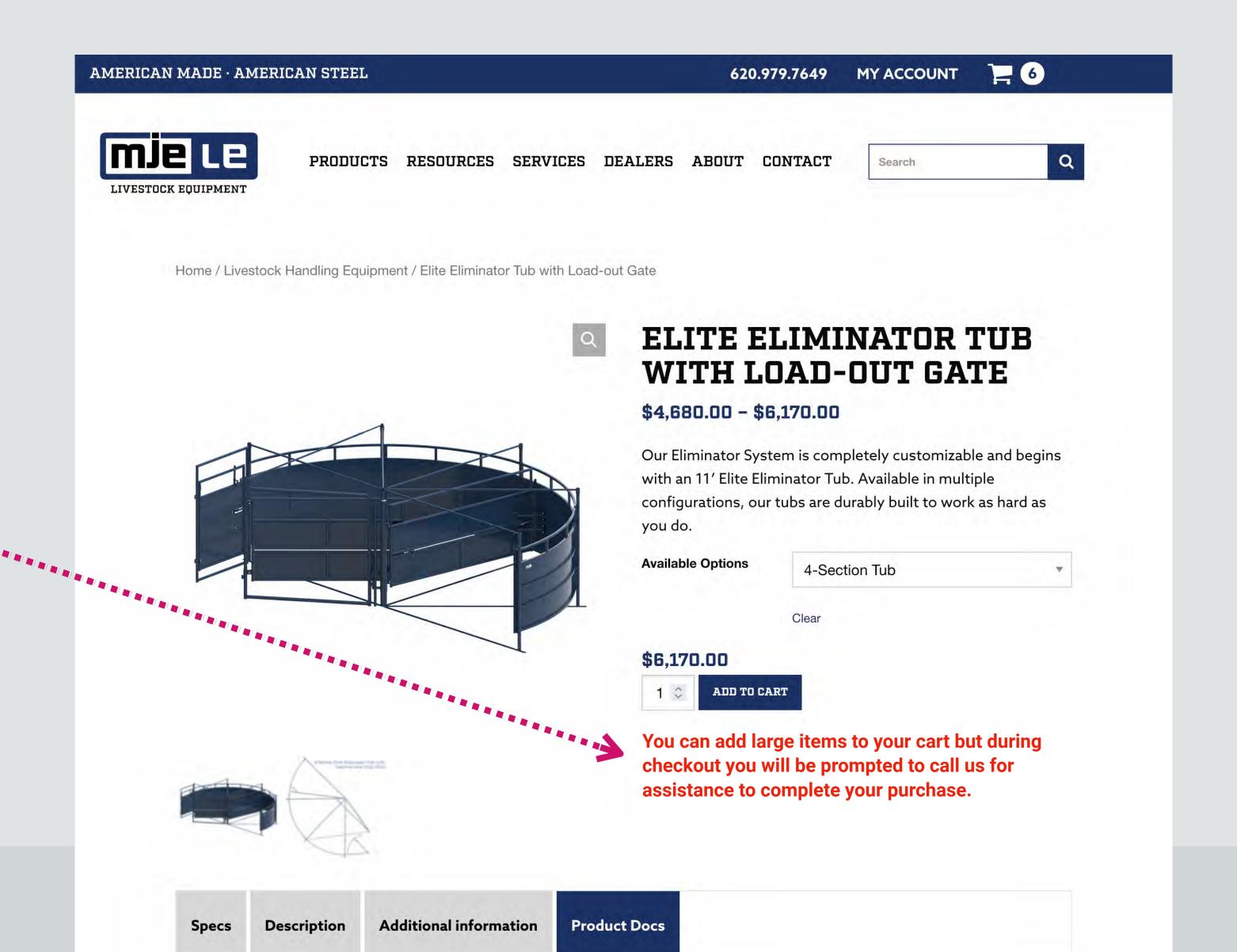

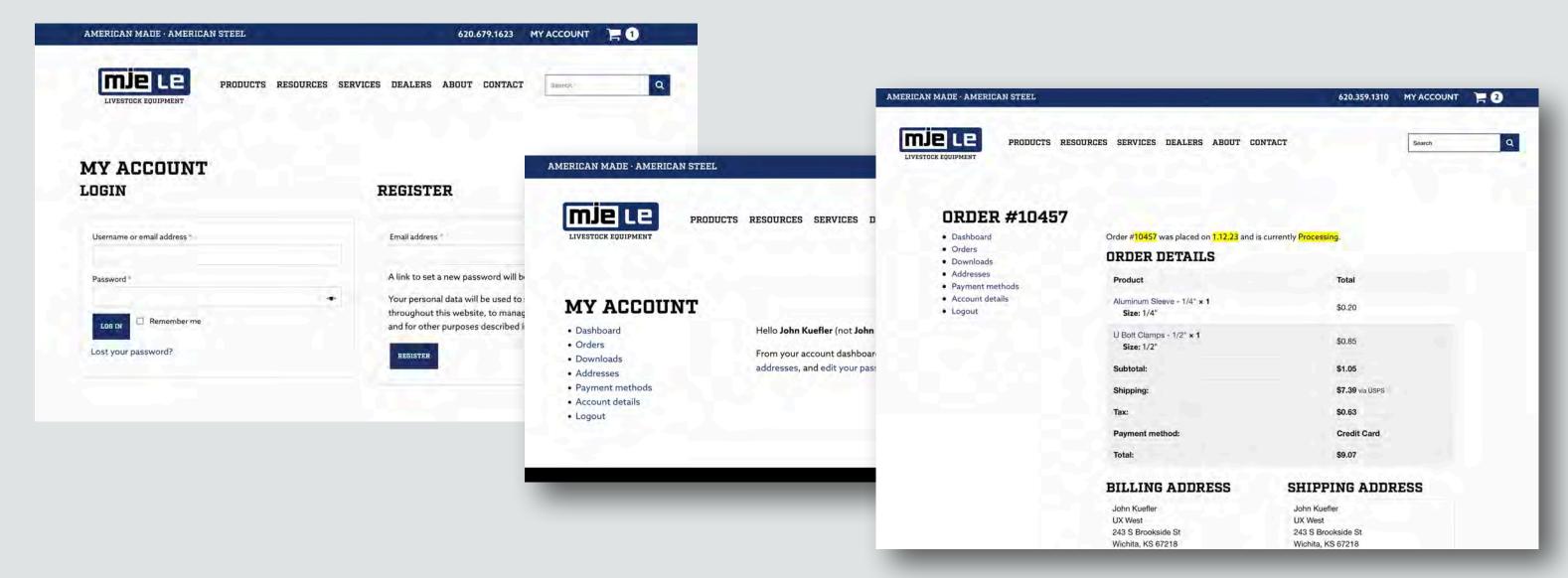


CHECKOUT EXPERIENCE
